PURPOSE

The purpose of the qualification is to ensure competent professional driving competence in the road transport sector, thus improving earning capacity of professional drivers as well as transport sector professionalism and economic growth.

Rules regarding Fundamental, Core and Electives:

- Fundamental unit standards totalling 36 credits are compulsory.
- Core unit standards totalling 30 credits are compulsory.
- Elective unit standards totalling a minimum of 56 credits.

ENTRY CRITERIA

- Learners will be assessed to determine their experience and prior learning knowledge. This will determine what skills will be RPLed and which will be gap trained.
- Mathematical Literacy at NQF Level 2.
- Communication competency at NQF Level 2.
- Medical certificate & eye test OR current PrDP licence .
- · All legislative requirements in accordance with driving licenses in South Africa, learners will need to have:
 - One of the drivers licenses below.
 - Be older than 25 years.
 - Be in a position to obtain a drivers license if needed before achieving this qualification.
 - The applicable license for the vehicle specialisation chosen in the qualification.
 - EC drivers licence.
- Equal to or below 16000 kg requires C1 drivers licence.
- Above 16000kg requires C drivers licence.
- Equal to or below 3500 kg requires B drivers licence.

- · Obtaining and communicating road transport operational information.
- Assessing loads against given permissible load requirements.
- Planning road transport service delivery that meets specified requirements.
- Driving a vehicle conveying a specific freight commodity or category of passengers.

- Planning the establishment of a small business according to relevant business principles OR
- Conduct vehicle maintainance according to specified procedures OR
- Operate lifting equipment according to specified procedures


